Personal Statement of Health

A doctor's certificate is required when applying for a C1(E), C(E), D1(E), D(E) class driving licence or taxi/bus driver's permit, or if you have answered one or more questions below with «yes». If only questions no. 1 or 2 have a «yes» answer, a certificate from an officially approved optician is sufficient for class A, B(E), S, T, M.

- 1. Do you wear eyeglasses or contact lenses when you drive?
2. Do you have impaired vision or reduced peripheral vision in one or both eyes?
3. Have you had spells with loss of consciousness in the course of the last 12 months?
4. Have you had or been treated for serious mental illness?
5. Do you take any medications permanently or regularly?
6. Do you misuse alcohol or other drugs?
7. Do you use insulin and/or tablets to control diabetes mellitus?
8. Do you have reduced mobility in your arms and/or legs?
9. Do you have other medical conditions that render or can render you unfit to drive a motor vehicle?

Supplementary information:

I hereby declare that I am aware of the health requirements of the driving licence regulations. The information above is complete. I am aware that providing incorrect or erroneous information is a punishable offence.

Doctor's certificate (Form no. NA 0202)

When applying for a class A1, A, B, BE, M, T or S driving licence, a doctor's certificate is not required unless because of the personal statement of health or for other reasons the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency is uncertain whether the applicant meets the health criteria.

A doctor's certificate is always required for class C, CE, C1, C1E, D, DE, D1 or D1E, including when renewing.

A doctor's certificate is also required in certain cases when applying for an extension of these classes.

Certain illnesses require an additional statement from a specialist.

Further rules on the requirements regarding health and doctor's certificates etc. are given in the driving licence regulations.

Tax card stub or other public document showing the applicant's full name and national identity number.

Applicants must show their driving licence when applying for a driving licence in a new class or when renewing a driving licence. No other proof of national identity no. is required if the national identity no. is on the driving licence.

Proof of driver's training. Before taking the driving test, applicants must produce documentation showing that they have undergone the obligatory training required for the relevant driving licence class:

Photographs shall be submitted when the driving licence is issued unless it has already been saved electronically.

Fees: A separate fee shall be paid in advance for each theoretical and each practical driving test, as well as for the issuing of the driving licence, see Section 14-2 of the Driving Licence Regulations.
