Information about applying for an assisted theory test for special-needs candidates

If you have reading or writing difficulties or otherwise have problems answering written questions, you may apply for an assisted theory test (theory test for special needs candidates).

You may also apply for such a test if you have a foreign language background and do not have a good command of Norwegian.

If you wish to take an assisted (special-needs) theory test, you must provide documentation that confirms that this is necessary and attach it to this application. Examples of such documentation could be a letter from your medical doctor/GP, from a speech therapist, or others who can document your need for an assisted test. If such documentation is not attached, the application will not be processed.

Most Driver and Vehicle Licensing Offices in Norway provide assisted oral theory tests with an examiner, but not all can offer interpreter-assisted tests. Contact the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Office you wish to use to find out which services they offer.

The overview below lists the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Offices that offer interpreter-assisted theory tests. Such tests take place via a computer screen, so that you and the interpreter may be in different parts of the country.

You are responsible for booking a certified interpreter. You yourself must pay the cost of the interpreter.
