



# Repair and upgrade work on the E136 Innfjordtunnelen and Måndalstunnelen

INFORMATION

February 2018



Until Summer 2018, the Norwegian Public Roads Administration will be performing repair and upgrade work on Innfjordtunnelen and Måndalstunnelen to make them safer for you as a road user.

## Traffic flow

**Innfjordtunnelen** are closed between 18:00 and 06:00, with convoy driving at fixed times:

### Departing from Innfjorden at

19:00, 20:00, 21:30, 23:00, 00:15, 02:15, 04:15

### Departing from Veblungsnes at

19:15, 20:15, 21:45, 23:15, 00:30, 02:30, 04:00

Odd-numbered weeks: Free passage from 02.15 on Saturday to 18.00 on Monday.

## Måndalstunnelen:

Traffic flow will be maintained using continuous escorted convoy driving between 18:00 and 06:00 in one direction at a time on the old road outside the tunnel or through the tunnel. Road users must expect up to 15 minutes waiting time.

## Diversion

Road users travelling to/from eastern Norway can take the diverted route via national road Rv 15 Strynefjellet.

During the summer half of the year, the route via national road Fv 63 Trollstigen can be used as a diverted route for vehicles less than 13.1 metres in length.

## Tunnel upgrades

We are replacing all of electrotechnical installations and safety equipment in both tunnels. Both Innfjordtunnelen and Måndalstunnelen will have broadcasting systems for DAB installed, new water and frost protection, fire ventilation, concrete railing throughout the tunnel length, and new turning bays. In addition Innfjordtunnelen will have surveillance cameras, loudspeakers, and continuous emergency lighting installed.
