## Information for special needs candidates

You may apply for an assisted theory test (for special needs candidates) if you have reading or writing difficulties or otherwise have problems answering written questions.

An assisted theory test may be carried out in Norwegian or English, or with an interpreter. We recommend that you apply for an interpreter-assisted test if you find it difficult to communicate in Norwegian. The examiner may interrupt the test and refer you to an interpreter-assisted test if it is difficult for you to understand each other.

When you apply for an assisted theory test, you need to provide documentation confirming that you need assistance. This may be a statement from your driving instructor, a speech therapist, or others who can document your need.
